Through the longer routes, you can broadly experience the geologically historical and valuable areas of the Lauhanvuori – Hämeenkangas UNESCO Global Geopark and, if necessary, the entire diversity of Southern Ostrobothnia.

Two National Parks' cycling route in Kauhajoki

How does 80 kilometers and two national parks sound? Explore the stunning landscapes of Lauhanvuori and Kauhaneva-Pohjankangas National Parks and the *Hyypänjokilaakso valley* by mountain biking! The route follows forest roads and quiet country roads, offering sights such as *Kauhaneva*, Lake *Spitaalijärvi*, and the *Lauhanvuori tower*.

South Ostrobothnia Geopark tour

Traverse the wonders of the Geopark. Experience two national parks, stunning river valleys, and the cultural landscapes of the plains by bike! The 180 km long route offers geological attractions and takes you to some of the most beautiful sites in Southern Ostrobothnia, such as *Susiluola* and *Iso-Kakkori*. Enjoy nature and visit remarkable swamps and historical sites along the way.

National parks also have their own cycling routes!



Muinaisvuori trails

Come experience the trail that follows the remnants of ancient mountains! You can choose a suitable distance for yourself from the Muinaisvuori trail network or cycle through the entire route. Although the route mainly runs through commercial forests, you will find vast fields of devil's stones, ravines, rock walls, groves, and rich flora, including marshlands shaped by the Ice Age.

Kyrönjoki Road Trip

Kyrönjoki is surely familiar to many, and it flows through Southern Ostrobothnia. The agricultural plains along the river have been selected as one of Finland's national landscapes. The route is about 214 km long and is suitable for a multinight trip. The route starts from the Lauhanvuori National Park in Isojoki and traverses the typical Southern Ostrobothnian landscape, ending at the Vähäkyrö church. The river continues its journey to Vaasa and all the way to the sea.
